DRESS STANDARDS

Members and their guests are expected to be well presented.
Clean, Neat and Tidy at all times when using the Club Facilities

ACCEPTABLE CASUAL WEAR

This covers a broad range of fashion apparel including:

- * Tracksuits designed as fashion wear.
- * Neat Denim Garments.
- * Bowlers Uniforms.
- * Shorts, mid length worn with appropriate socks as necessary.
- Dress Sandals with toe cap and shell strap.
- Headwear may be worn correctly.

NOT ACCEPTABLE

- Bare feet - footwear **MUST** be worn at all times.
- Singlets, sleeveless shirts or provocative clothing.
- Untidiness - torn, cut off, faded or frayed clothing.
- Bare midriff tops.
- Scuffs or thongs (permitted before 7:30pm).
- Swimwear.
- Football shorts, short shorts, stobbies or similar.
(permitted before 7:30pm).
- Worn or Dirty footwear.
- Sports jerseys (permitted before 7:30pm).
- Tracksuits (permitted before 7:30pm).
- Dirty Overalls.

The final decision with regard to the interpretation of Dress Regulations remains the responsibility of the Duty Manager.
